## *Admission Process*

The Juvenile TASC Program will provide assessment and referral to youth under the age of 18 who are involved with the above entities.

A comprehensive screening, which includes evidenced based psychometric testing is conducted to determine treatment modalities, as well as urinalysis testing.

## ***Eligibility Criteria***

The Juvenile TASC Program serves youth under the age of 18 referred by the Department of Juvenile Justice, the Courts and other community partners due to involvement or risk of involvement with DJJ and have current and/or previous behavioral, mental health or substance misuse.



## ***Juvenile TASC Program***

The Juvenile TASC Program coordinates treatment and other needed services through a comprehensive and coordinated approach.

If eligible, treatment opportunities are available through Aspire's Adolescent Programs. Sliding Fee Scale may apply.



## ***Core Services offered by Juvenile TASC Program :***

- Assessment Services for eligible youth using an evidence based tool
- Recommendation and Referral to Services
- Random Urinalysis testing
- Report Provided to referral source, with brief case monitoring
